Admiral Heights Residents RECYCLE! “Saving the world, one lug at a time.”

Junkluggers got quite a haul when it held an electronics and scrap metal recycling event in Admiral Heights on Sept. 10. One resident brought 20 cell phones; another, six computers; still another, a couple of lawn chairs.

Owned and operated by Sarah Kingsland and Brian Thurston, Junkluggers opened in May 2020 in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic. With everyone stuck at home cleaning and trying to get rid of goods, the company received lots of calls for help from both homes and businesses. “We want to keep stuff out of the dump and help the environment,” Brian said. “For paying customers, we’ll pick up anything except hazardous materials.”

Junkluggers partners with Habitat for Humanity which uses the new or gently recycled furniture and refurbishes the rest. Proceeds from events, like the one held in Admiral Heights, are matched and donated to the Baltimore Animal Rescue and Care Shelter (BARCS).

The Admiral Heights Improvement Association (AHIA) was made aware of the company’s community service through Trish May, a realtor for Keller Williams Integrity who has family connections to the community. Trish knew about Junkluggers’ work with the Coalition of Geriatric Services (COGS) out of Howard County. Impressed with Junkluggers’ eco-friendly events, Trish asked Shivaugn Ahern, association president, if Admiral Heights would be interested in holding an event. Ahern swiftly decided that there was enough community interest. “The AHIA Board (of Directors) wants to do activities that bring benefit to the community and show a value to AHIA membership,” Ahern said.
